 - c. Furnish certified malleable iron castings or heavy gage steel stampings.
 - d. Factory finish all metal parts, except backboard, with one coat of black enamel or powder coat finish.
 - e. Location and Quantity: Refer to Drawings.
- 2. Structure Wall Mounted Backstops:
 - a. General:
 - 1) Extend backboard from wall with four 1 7/8 inches ID steel pipes (or sizes per manufacturer).
 - 2) Space extension ends 66 inches apart horizontally.
 - 3) Wall Mounting Pads: 2 inches by 6 inches red oak, varnished.

- b. Wall Mounted Vertically Adjustable Backstop (D No. SW) (Jay No. WMWH):
 - 1) Confirm mounting at locations of the existing units.
 - 2) Provide all cross bracing and chain supports as required for support and as recommended by manufacturer.
 - 3) Provide for vertical adjustment from 7'-6" to 10'-0" with crank or other similar device for adjustment.







UNIT "D" FIRST FLOOR EQUIPMENT PLAN SCALE: 1/8" = 1'-0"
